How to make your own ottoman

What you need

- 10 Large Cardboard Boxes
- Cushioning Foam
- Duct Tape
- Strong Glue
- Plastic Paper (to make it waterproof)
- Cloth for the Exterior

Step 1



Cut your cardboard into 30x30cm squares and stack each square up to your desired height, placing glue on each corner as you make the pile.

Step 2



Place a heavy book on your complete pile to keep it in place and secure it further with duct tape.

Step 3



Use extra box pieces to secure the sides and add the plastic to your square, taping it up like a gift!

Step 4



Measure cushioning for each side and glue cloth to the "front" of each cushion piece.

Step 5



Add the cushioning to your box, securing it with more glue!
Decorate as desired.
